HAROLD WIGGS, 76, passed away Monday, November 13, 1995. Harold lived a life of devotion to his family and commitment to his community. As a lifelong resident of El Paso, he returned from WWII as the city's most decorated war hero, soon after, he opened the Wiggs Appliance Company which he operated for 41 years. Harold Wiggs was also well known for his distinguished contribution to the El Paso School Board, he was elected President of the board in 1970 and served for 14 years until he resigned in 1988; Harold Wiggs Middle School was named in his honor. His many other civic activities and honors include Distinguished Alumni of New Mexico State University, President of the Sun Bowl Association, Outstanding Citizen Award, Conquistador Award and his induction into the Historical Society Hall of Fame. He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Mary Louise Wiggs; his three children, Toni Wiggs Paul; David H. Wiggs, Jr. and his wife, Michele and Susan Wiggs George and her husband, Bob; his eight grandchildren, Dayne Lunn Creighton and her husband, Sam, Kerri Folmer-Rende and her husband, John, Richard Fritz Munsinger, David H.
