

## **MRS. ANNIE WILLIAMS DIES; WAS PIONEER EL PASOAN**

Word has been received by Mrs. D. W. Reckhart, 305 San Francisco street, of the death of Mrs. Annie Williams, a pioneer resident of El Paso, at her home in Los Angeles, the Francis hotel, Tuesday night. Mrs. Williams was the wife of Thomas Williams, one of the old conductors on the Santa Fe railroad running out of El Paso.

Mrs. Williams was the last manager of the old Columbia hotel, which was in a building at the corner of West San Antonio and Chihuahua streets, owned by Zach T. White. She left El Paso about 10 years ago and moved to Los Angeles with her children.

Deceased is survived by two sons and a daughter, who live in California.
