

J. E. WILLIAMS, FATHER OF MOVIE STAR, BURIED

The funeral of J. E. Williams, 65, 1309 East California street, who died at a local hospital Saturday was held from the Peak chapel Monday afternoon, Rev. J. F. Williams officiating. Burial was in Concordia cemetery, where the Order of Odd Fellows took charge.

Mr. Williams is the father of Kathlyn Williams, the famous moving picture star, who is in Los Angeles, Cal., and who sent a telegram stating that she was not able to attend the funeral because of the late time in being notified. She is expected to arrive here in the near future.

Decedent was a resident of El Paso for 15 years, having come from Butte, Mont. He was the owner of the Mount Franklin bakery for five years up to two years ago, when he accepted a position in the quartermaster's warehouse. Being offered a position with the Roswell Military institute as managing purchaser, he left the latter position three months ago only to return a short while later for an operation from which he never survived.

Those surviving are his widow and two step daughters, Mrs. Roy H. Hall and Mrs. M. H. Fletcher, of El Paso; and one daughter by former marriage, Kathlyn Williams, of Los Angeles.
