

Resident Of El Paso For 85 Years Dies

Funeral services for Mrs. Rosita Wilson of 917 North Stanton street will be held in Immaculate Conception church at 9 a. m. tomorrow. Father Clarkson will officiate.

Rostary service will be held in the church at 7:30 p. m. today.

Mrs. Wilson was 85. She was born Rosita Casares, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Alvino Casares, who came to El Paso from Spain. She lived in El Paso all her life.
