

Civil War Veteran Is Taken By Death

Funeral services for John A. Winram, 93, veteran of the northern forces during the Civil war, who died at the residence of a daughter, Mrs. Georgia Belle Houghton, 717 Wellesley road, yesterday, will be held at the Peak-Hagedon chapel at 3:30 p. m. today. The Rev. Malcolm N. Twiss will officiate. Burial will be in Masonic cemetery.

Mr. Winram was a lieutenant in the Union navy during the war. He first came to El Paso in 1884.

Mr. Winram was one of the two surviving members of the El Paso chapter of the G. A. R., when it was disbanded two years ago.

Beside Mrs. Houghton he is survived by another daughter, Mrs. E. W. Myers, 3204 Morehead avenue.
