

Member Of EP Pioneer Family Dies Here

Mrs. Alice Davis Wise, 62, native of El Paso and member of a pioneer southwestern family, died in her home, 1702 North Raynor Street, Thursday.

Mrs. Wise, prominent in religious and social circles for many years, was the daughter and sister of two former El Paso mayors. Her brother, the late Charles Davis, Jr., who died a few months ago, served as El Paso's mayor, as did his father before him. Mrs. Wise's father, the late Charles Davis, Sr., served as collector of customs in El Paso during the administration of President Grover Cleveland.

Mrs. Wise was educated in El Paso schools and attended colleges in Virginia and Tarrytown, N. Y. She was married to W. D. Wise in 1909. He survives her. Mrs. Wise was a member of St. Clement's Episcopal Church.

Other survivors include a niece, Mrs. Frances Kelly, Cuernavaca, Mexico; a nephew, Capt. Gates Davis, U. S. Army, and a greatniece, Alice Flournoy Davis, and two cousins, Mrs. Lucille Ealy, Los Angeles, Calif., and Melton Wilson, Bryan Texas.
