

Judge Crosby's Daughter To Be Buried Monday

Funeral services for Mrs. Madeline C. Wood, formerly of El Paso, who died Thursday in New York, will be held at 10 o'clock Monday morning in Peak-Hagedon chapel, with the Rev. C. H. Horner officiating. Burial will be in the family plot in Concordia cemetery.

Mrs. Wood was the daughter of the late Judge and Mrs. J. F. Crosby, early settlers in El Paso. Judge Crosby was one of the owners of the original El Paso township site.

Mrs. Wood was born and reared here, receiving her early education in the El Paso schools. It was here she met and married H. R. Wood, a prominent El Paso real estate and insurance man. H. R. Wood died here 20 years ago.

Since her husband's death Mrs. Wood had made her home in New York city with a sister, Mrs. Virginia B. Moran.

Peak-Hagedon announced last night Mrs. Wood's body will be received here early Monday morning, accompanied by a sister, Mrs. Marie Hardcastle, and a nephew, Walter C. Hardcastle of Houston, Tex.
