

MRS. LEWIS WOODUL TAKEN BY DEATH

Funeral Services to Be Held in El Paso Tomorrow

Mrs. Lewis Woodul, 31, of San Luis Potosi, Mex., daughter of Mrs. Eliza Herrien Loomis, died today at 1 p. m. in San Antonio of complications following pneumonia.

She was the mother of a two weeks' old daughter, Elizabeth.

Mrs. Loomis and her sister, Mrs. J. Worth Maxwell of Mexico, Mr. Woodul and his father, C. E. Woodul, will arrive tomorrow from San Antonio with the body.

The funeral will be held tomorrow afternoon.

Mrs. Woodul, the former Elizabeth Loomis, was born here and is a member of one of El Paso's oldest families.

She is a graduate of El Paso High school and attended the College of Mines.

She is the granddaughter of E. V. Barrien of El Paso.

Her paternal grandparents were the late Mr. and Mrs. A. M. Loomis. Her father is Ralph Loomis of El Paso.
