Member of N. M. Legislature
Dies At La Union

Funeral services for Joseph Austin Wright of La Union, N. M., who died at his home yesterday, will be held at Kastar and Maxon Chapel at 2 p. m. today. He was 69.

Mr. Wright was a member of the New Mexico legislature and a director of the Elephant Butte Irrigation District. He had been in failing health for the past year.

Mr. Wright was born in Fayetteville, Ark. He had been a representative of Wells Fargo Express Co. in Mexico for many years.

He was an officer in the Globe Mills Co. and Consumers Ice Co. while a resident of El Paso. He made his home in El Paso and the valley for the last 28 years.
