

## **ISADOR ZORK DIES AT SAN ANTONIO**

News was received yesterday of the death in San Antonio of Isador Zork, member of a pioneer San Antonio and El Paso family, and one time El Paso resident.

Mrs. Gustave Zork, 525 Los Angeles street, his sister-in-law, and her son, Luis Zork, were among the surviving relatives at the bedside. Others included Edwin Steffian, New York stepson. Other survivors are the widow, Mrs. Tillie Krakauer Steffian Zork, to whom the deceased was married May 17, 1916; sisters, Mrs. Ada Krakauer, 1715 North Stanton street; Mrs. E. Moya, 617 Cincinnati street; Mrs. Jacob Loeh, New York, and Ella Gugenheim, Dallas, and Herbert Zork, brother, San Antonio, and many nieces and nephews in El Paso and San Antonio.

Mr. Zork, born in San Antonio, January 8, 1864, was connected with M. Halff & Brother, engaged in the wholesale dry goods business in that city for 45 years. When he lived here he was in the produce business under the firm name of Zork-Smith company.
