

Dies In House Where She Was Born In 1853

In a house at San Elizario, where her family lived for more than 100 years, Mrs. Felicitas Zuniga died last night.

She was 85 and was born in 1853 in the house in which she died.

Mrs. Zuniga's husband died in 1929. He was one of the settlement's Indian fighters of the '70s.

He fought the Mescaleros in the Guadalupe and Sacramento mountains along with Jesus Montes, only surviving San Elizario member of the veteran Indian fighters.

Mrs. Zuniga's life was without spectacle, her daughter, Mrs. Ursula Fleishman of Los Angeles, said today. She lived quietly and happily rearing her family.

She is survived by five children and 25 grand children.

The children are Mrs. Fleishman, Josefa Vincente, Pasqual and Bonafacio.

Funeral services will be held at 5 p. m. today in the Catholic Church at San Elizario. Martin Mortuary is in charge.
