Oppenheim Rites Set For Today

Funeral services for Mrs. Adele S. Oppenheim, 70, who died Monday morning in a local hospital, will be held at 3 p. m. Tuesday in the Harding and Orr Chapel.

Mrs. Oppenheim, a resident of El Paso for 35 years, was operator and manager of the House of Oppenheim in Juarez for 20 years. She retired in 1948. She was a native of Germany and the widow of the late Jacob Oppenheim, who died in 1929. She was a member of Temple Mt. Sinai.
