"I worked for J. J. and L. L. Mundy years ago when they named several streets for early El Pascons. Starting with Crosby Street, the next street was Hill Street, then followed Lowenstein, Schute, Nagus, Blacker and Blanchard, all named for early El Pascons.

"Due to confusion between Hill Street and Hills Street, the name was changed to High Street, which is the street at the rear of the El Paso High School.
