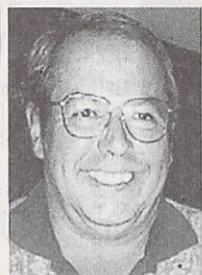

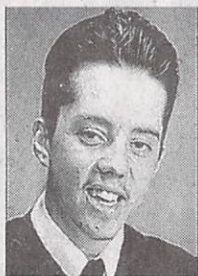
RUIZ
