Rites Thursday For H. P. Talley

Funeral services for Atty. Herman P. Talley, 77, of 352 Ridgemont, who practiced law in El Paso for 47 years, will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday from the Harding Orr & McDaniel Montana Chapel. The Rev. Fayeth Fox will officiate and burial will be in Memory Garden.

Talley was born in Jeffersonville, Ind., coming to Texas with his family and attending public schools in the state and the University of Texas. In 1923 he was an attorney for the U.S. Bureau of Revenue, at Houston, and was transferred to El Paso in 1925. In 1928 he resigned to enter the private practice of law.

He was active in Masonic work and was the first member of Sunland Lodge 1344 to receive a 50-year pin, in 1967. In 1950 he was an unsuccessful candidate for county commissioner. He has been a member of the Chamber of Commerce, El Paso Scottish Rite Bodies, El Maida Shrine, Elks Lodge 187, El Paso Board of Realtors, a County Volunteer Parole Board, the Methodist Church and Unity Temple, in addition to local, state and American bar associations.

Survivors include his widow, Mrs. Margaret Talley of El Paso; five daughters, Mrs. Frank Godfrey, Mrs. Ivy McGehee, Mrs. Blake A. Hewitt of Las Cruces, N.M., Miss Oma Talley and Miss Diane Talley, both of El Paso; one sister and two brothers, residents of Houston.
