Ysleta District Asks Hacienda School Bids

The Ysleta Independent School District today asked for bids on construction of its new Hacienda Heights grade school. Bids will be opened at 8 p. m., May 21.

Of a recent Federal Security Administration grant, \$243,252 has been allotted for the base unit of the new school.

Superintendent J. M. Hanks said only the base unit, consisting of 12 classrooms, library, cafeteria and administrative offices, will be built now.

Plan Alternate Bids

However, alternate bids will be received at the same time on additional units to include six more classrooms and an auditorium-gymnasium. These will be constructed later.

The new school will be built on the heights overlooking North Loop road, and will serve the growing Rosedale, Hacienda Heights and Half Moon Circle residential areas. The federal grant was to help the district care for an influx of military children.

Six Classrooms

Carroll and Dauble, architects, said the Hacienda Heights building, although containing some features of the Mesita School, will be their best and most modern design. It will be of reinforced concrete and masonry construction with outside face brick.

The base unit includes six primary classrooms in one wing,

shown at the right in the sketch, as well as teachers rooms, book rooms, offices, and rest rooms. In the center will be the cafeteria and kitchen. The wing at the left includes six upper elementary classrooms, library, and student rest rooms.

Construction features include two-way lighting in all classrooms, with north windows extending from ceiling to two feet above floors, acoustical treatment throughout, asphalt tile floors, steel double-hung windows, toilets built inside primary grade rooms, lockers and work center in upper elementary rooms.

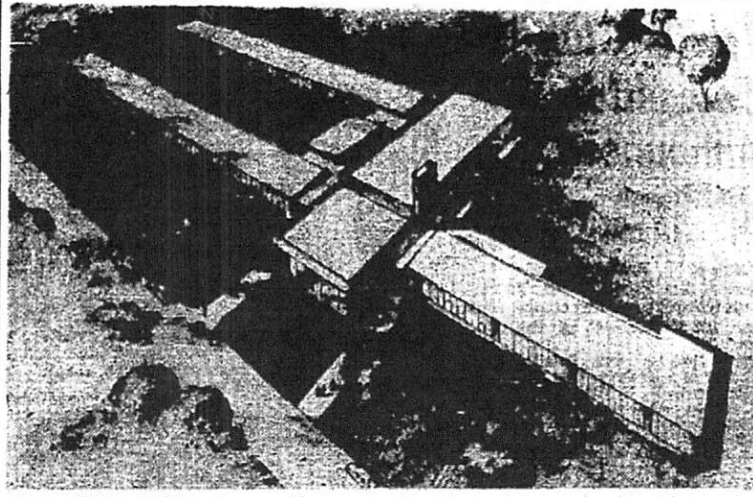
An Alternate Bid

Alternate bid No. 1 is for the wing of six additional classrooms to be constructed later. Alternate bid No. 2 includes the auditorium, stage, and arts and crafts rooms.

The Hacienda Heights school is one unit in the district's extensive construction program, financed by a \$1,000,000 bond issue voted last January and a recent FCA allotment of \$597,585.
