

## Anthony woman was activist

Hazel B. Milikien, a longtime Anthony, Texas, community and civic activist, volunteer and retired postal service employee, died Dec. 7, 1992. She was 80.

She was active in the Anthony Crescent Club and the Anthony United Methodist church, was a volunteer for the local food bank, and taught adult reading and English classes.

She was a charter member of the Anthony Civic Club and a member and supporter of other organizations including the American Association of Retired Persons, Pro Musica and the El Paso Museum of Art.

She moved to El Paso in 1988.

Survivors include her daughters, Norma L. Milikien and Loy Del Doty; and her sons, Stephen Lloyd Milikien and Timothy Bert Milikien. Her husband, Jessie, died in 1990.
