

# Clint Banker Dies Suddenly

W. D. Hawes, 62, prominent Clint insurance man and bank director died Tuesday night in the Treece Hospital, Fabens, after he was stricken earlier in the day.

He had been a resident of the Lower Valley for 29 years, coming here from Elberton, Ga. He had been a director of the First National Bank of Fabens for the past four years and had managed the Hendricks and Hawes Insurance Agency. He was a member of Masonic Lodge 130, El Maida Shrine, and the First Baptist Church, Clint.

Survivors include his widow, Mrs. Mary Hawes, and three brothers, including A. S. Hawes, of Abilene, Texas. Funeral arrangements with Harding and Orr Funeral Home were pending upon the arrival of the brothers in Clint, expected Wednesday.
